

**Chamber Business Solutions Trust
Participating Employer
Product Dues Acknowledgement**

The Kentucky Chamber of Commerce (“KCC”) is offering a self-insured employer-organized group health benefit program through the Chamber Business Solutions Trust (“CBS.”) CBS is a chamber member benefit available to employer groups belonging to an authorized chamber of commerce that belongs to the Kentucky Chamber of Commerce Executive Association. Employers who elect to participate in CBS (“Participating Employers”) have elected to offer CBS to their eligible employees and their family members. The Participating Employer agrees to the following:

1. The Participating Employer will remain a member in good standing with at least one chamber of commerce (identified below) authorized by KCC to offer CBS to its members.
2. The Participating Employer agrees to pay product dues assessed by the KCC from its general assets. The product dues charged will be calculated at \$4.00 per enrolled employee per month. The product dues will be based upon the number of employees that participate as of the renewal date of each year, or the Participating Employer’s original effective date, if different from the Plan renewal date. The product dues will be invoiced annually and must be paid in full within thirty (30) days of receiving the invoice.
3. The Participating Employer elects the President and CEO of the Kentucky Chamber of Commerce to be its proxy to elect Trustees for the CBS.
4. The Participating Employer agrees to comply with all the rules and requirements of CBS as outlined in the CBS Participation Agreement and updated from time to time. Failure to comply with the Arrangement’s rules and requirements may result in the Participating Employer being terminated from participating in CBS.

This Acknowledgement is effective when signed by the Participating Employer.
